What data do we collect?

IPARTNER collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, company)

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide IPARTNER with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or place an order for any of our products or services.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

How will we use your data?

IPARTNER collects your data so that we can:

- Process your order, manage your account.
- Email you with special offers on other products and services we think you might like.

IPARTNER will not share your data with another companies.

When IPARTNER processes your order, it may send your data to, and also use the resulting information from, credit reference agencies to prevent fraudulent purchases.

How do we store your data?

IPARTNER securely stores your data in European cloud in an encrypted container linked to our CRM.

IPARTNER will keep your personal identification information for three (3) years after your last order. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data by an automatic process in our CRM.

Marketing

IPARTNER would like to send you information about products and services of ours that we think you might like.

If you have agreed to receive marketing, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop IPARTNER from contacting you for marketing purposes or giving your data to other members of the IPARTNER Group.

What are your data protection rights?

IPARTNER would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request IPARTNER for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that IPARTNER correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request IPARTNER to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure — You have the right to request that IPARTNER erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that IPARTNER restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to IPARTNER's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that IPARTNER transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
